

GS-11 STAFF AUDITOR PROMOTION CRITERIA

AUDITOR, GS-511-11

Upon successful demonstration of work performance at the GS-9 Staff Auditor position, persons may apply for promotional consideration to the GS-11 Staff Auditor position. Promotion to the GS-11 Staff Auditor position is not automatic and applicants must meet the requisite criteria as defined below.

Minimum Requirements

Demonstrated Satisfactory Completion of GS-9 Staff Auditor: must plan, conduct and complete audit assignments. Also, must successfully demonstrate working knowledge of conventional audit techniques to complete relatively uncomplicated evaluations. Must be able to work and participate in a team environment and have professional knowledge of accounting and auditing practices.

Perform as a GS-9 Staff Auditor at or above the Fully Satisfactory Level for a minimum of 1 year.

Recommendation from immediate Supervisor

Available Auditor Case Load at GS-11 level

Ability to travel 25%

Acceptable Education Prerequisites:

- Bachelor degree from accredited 4-year institution with major in any subject, but incumbent must have 21 semester-hour credits in accounting and 6 semester-hour credits in economics plus one year of experience at grade GS-8.
- Associate's degree from accredited 2-year institution with identical accounting and economics coursework plus two years of experience at GS 7/8.
